The school receives an annual dividend from the school land trust. Our council decides how these funds will be used. This year our school received and spent approximately \$107,000.00 from the School LAND Trust Program. The council also reviews academic plans for our students each year and acts in an advisory capacity to school and school district administrations. All plans are submitted for final approval to the school board.

### Qualifications

Every public school in Utah has a School Community Council. The councils are made up of school employees and parents who are elected by parents of students who attend SCHS. Membership terms are for two years. Elections are held at the beginning of each school year. Parent members must have a student attending SCHS at least one of the two years of their term of service. Employees must be employed by the school district at SCHS.
